1. **Kelp Farm, South of Sheffield Island, Jean Paul Vellotti, Westport, CT.**
The applicant plans to construct a seasonal kelp farm in the vicinity south of Sheffield Island. The system will be deployed in late fall and removed in early spring.
2. **14 Harborview Avenue, Norwalk #7-17 CAM Application.** The applicant, Richard Pulcini, is proposing to construct a new single family dwelling and an elevated deck.
3. **80 Seaview Avenue, Norwalk #8-17 CAM application.** The applicant plans to construct a new elevated deck for public access; relocate an existing shed landward and adjacent to the new deck; and repair an existing seawall adjacent to Norwalk Boat and Yacht Club.
4. **5 Decker Street, Norwalk; Pre-application.** The applicants, Thomas and Allison Robbins, plan to construct a private residential dock and pier within Norwalk Harbor.

5. **Pecks Ledge Lighthouse; Pre-application.** The applicant proposes to install an access structure comprised of a 6' x 25' fixed pier with a cantilevered 4' x 11' – 4" lower platform, three swivel davits, two built-in timber wave attenuators (one each side), three vertical access ladders and a 3' wide ship ladder at the landward end connecting to an existing lighthouse landing. Also proposed is the installation of a mooring and pulley line northeast of the pier.
