##### **1. RESOLUTION:**

WHEREAS, Section 1-289 of the Norwalk Charter requires that a majority of the Common Council vote to establish a specific spending limit on locally expenditures during the process of establishing the next fiscal year's operating budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NORWALK THAT:

The maximum limit on the total appropriation for the City of Norwalk for Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2023 shall be no more than \$402,559,982. This appropriation cap represents total expenditures of \$424,361,207 less estimated intergovernmental grants of \$21,801,225. Be it further resolved that the result of this vote and resolution, together with the attached 2023-2024 Budget Book, be forwarded by the Clerk of the City of Norwalk to the Board of Estimate and Taxation.
