FREE TREE REQUEST FORM

The City has trees available that can be planted on land designated for street trees (usually in the City-Owned Right-of-Way next to roads).

There is also an arrangement available which may provide a free tree on private property facing a City street. The designated planting area should be easily accessible, free of existing trees and obstacles, and at or close to grade level of the adjacent roadway. If eligible, the property owner would be asked to fill an Adopt A Tree Agreement in exchange for the tree(s).
